

## Troop 934 Beach Trip 2019 Packing List and Trip Details

### Friday Departure

- The bus leaves the lower parking lot at Mt. Tabor no later than 5.45pm on Friday, 4<sup>th</sup> October.
- Please arrive for check-in by 5.15pm
- Wear your Class A
- Bring a Bag Dinner

### Thursday Packing Party

- There will be a short packing party 7.00pm on Thursday.
  - Backside of the church (enter through gates on lower left)
- **IMPORTANT: EVERYONE -- Please bring personal gear to the packing party so that it can be loaded onto the trailer**
  - The trailer is leaving early (3.45pm) as the state park gate closes at 9.00pm.
  - Due to last minute "running around", it is difficult to collect and load personal gear Friday afternoon – please bring it Thursday night
  - It is a ¾ mile hike from the gate to the campground. We are running shuttle.
  - There is limited room on the white bus for personal gear. If you bring it, plan to sit on it.

### Personal Gear

- For camping
  - Sleeping bag, sleeping pad, small pillow. ENO hammocks are fine
  - 2-3 sets of clothes (shorts, t-shirts) + long pants, socks & hoodie should be enough
  - Raincoat
  - Hat, Sunglasses, Bug spray
  - Ditty Bag - Soap, Toothbrush/Paste, Deodorant, Towel, Comb, eyeglasses/contacts  
*(there is access to hot showers)*
- For the beach
  - Swimsuit, Towel, Closed Toe Shoes (for the beach hike)
  - Daypack with hat, sunglasses, sunscreen and at least one (preferably two) water bottles
- For surf fishing on Saturday (optional)
  - A rod & reel (anything will work) – Troop will provide tackle and bait
- For the Oceanography Merit Badge Class, you need
  - Closed-toe shoes -- flip flops not allowed per Aquarium rules – shoes WILL get wet/muddy
  - T-shirt/shorts that can also all get wet/muddy
  - A daypack (pack clean shorts and shoes for the ride home)
  - A towel, water bottle, sunscreen and bug spray
- It's a long trip to/from the beach
  - Limited electronics are OK
  - Headphones are REQUIRED for music
